MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION



Am I eligible to become a member?

Memberships are available to anyone 50 years or older, and only those individuals age 50-plus may participate in Senior Centre activities as non-members.

Where members with physical, developmental or medical challenges are accompanied by a personal caregiver, there shall be no financial charge for the caregiver to assist the individual in participating, unless the activity involves tickets for food or events. Further, the age requirement shall be waived for the caregiver.

What does a membership cost?

The cost for a membership is \$55.00 per person. Memberships cover a calendar year and expire on December 31st of the year of purchase.

Memberships renewed prior to the start of the new year, receive a \$10 discount, making the membership renewal cost \$45.00.

On July 1st, the fee for a NEW membership drops to \$35 per person. On October 1st, the fee for a NEW membership drops to \$15.00.

All renewing members must pay the full membership price, regardless of when they renew.

Members over 90 years of age who have been a paid member for three previous years will receive a free honorary membership. Members who turn 100 or more shall be considered lifetime members

Memberships may be paid for by cash or cheque, payable to the Tillsonburg Senior Centre. Memberships are non-refundable and non-transferrable.

Are there any requirements as a member or program participant?

All new members and program participants must provide information to create a profile for their account. In January of each year, all participants must sign a digital copy of the waiver, Code of Conduct, and Violence in the Workplace Policy.

All renewing members and program participants should review their personal information at the time of renewal and provide staff with any changes in personal information.
